PROBATION

The defendant is hereby sentenced to probation for a term of :

Sixty (60) months.

The defendant shall not commit another federal, state or local crime.

The defendant shall not unlawfully possess a controlled substance. The defendant shall refrain from any unlawful use of a controlled substance. The defendant shall submit to one drug test within 15 days of placement on probation and at least two periodic drug tests thereafter, as determined by the court.

The above drug testing condition is suspended, based on the court's determination that the defendant poses a low risk of future substance abuse. (Check, if applicable)

The defendant shall not possess a firearm, ammunition, destructive device, or any other dangerous weapon. (Check, if applicable)

The defendant shall cooperate in the collection of DNA as directed by the probation officer. (Check, if applicable)

The defendant shall comply with the requirements of the Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (42 U.S.C. § 16901, et seq.) as directed by the probation officer, the Bureau of Prisons, or any state sex offender registration agency in which he or she resides, works, is a student, or was convicted of a qualifying offense. (Check, if applicable)

If this judgment imposes a fine or restitution, it is a condition of probation that the defendant pay in accordance with the Schedule of Payments sheet of this judgment.

STANDARD CONDITIONS OF SUPERVISION

- 1) the defendant shall not leave the judicial district without the permission of the court or probation officer;
- 2) the defendant shall report to the probation officer in a manner and frequency directed by the court or probation officer;
- 3) the defendant shall answer truthfully all inquiries by the probation officer and follow the instructions of the probation officer;
- 4) the defendant shall support his or her dependents and meet other family responsibilities;
- 5) the defendant shall work regularly at a lawful occupation, unless excused by the probation officer for schooling, training, or other acceptable reasons;
- 6) the defendant shall notify the probation officer at least ten days prior to any change in residence or employment;
- 7) the defendant shall refrain from excessive use of alcohol and shall not purchase, possess, use, distribute, or administer any controlled substance or any paraphernalia related to any controlled substances, except as prescribed by a physician;
- 8) the defendant shall not frequent places where controlled substances are illegally sold, used, distributed, or administered;
- 9) the defendant shall not associate with any persons engaged in criminal activity and shall not associate with any person convicted of a felony, unless granted permission to do so by the probation officer;
- the defendant shall permit a probation officer to visit him or her at any time at home or elsewhere and shall permit confiscation of any contraband observed in plain view of the probation officer;
- 11) the defendant shall notify the probation officer within seventy-two hours of being arrested or questioned by a law enforcement officer;
- 12) the defendant shall not enter into any agreement to act as an informer or a special agent of a law enforcement agency without the permission of the court; and
- as directed by the probation officer, the defendant shall notify third parties of risks that may be occasioned by the defendant's criminal record or personal history or characteristics and shall permit the probation officer to make such notifications and to confirm the defendant's compliance with such notification requirement.

ADDITIONAL PROBATION TERMS

The defendant shall pay a \$100.00 special assessment which is immediately payable to the Clerk of the Court for the U. S. District Court, District of Columbia. Within 30 days of any change of address, the defendant shall notify the Clerk of the Court of the change until such time as the financial obligation is paid in full.

The defendant shall notify the Probation Office within 10 days prior to any change of address or employment.

Should the defendant be arrested in any country, he shall notify the Probation Office within 72 hours of such arrest.

While on probation, the defendant shall not possess a firearm or other dangerous weapon, shall not use or possess an illegal controlled substance, and shall not commit another federal, state, or local crime.

The defendant shall continue to cooperate with the government during the term of probation.

The defendant shall not export any U.S. origin goods to countries sanctioned by the U.S.

Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 14135a, for all felony offenses, the defendant shall submit to the collection and use of DNA identification information at the direction of the U.S. Probation Office.

Should the defendant re-enter the United States, he shall report to the U. S. Probation Office in the area where he intends to reside within 72 hours of his return.

The defendant shall submit quarterly written reports to the Probation Office.

The Court finds that the provision for submission of periodic drug tests, as required under 18 U.S.C. § 3563(a) and 3583(b), is suspended, as the defendant is believed to pose a low risk of future substance abuse.
