AMENDED ORDER ADOPTING IN PART MAGISTRATE JUDGE'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION AND GRANTING SUMMARY JUDGMENT AND DISSOLVING WRITS OF GARNISHMENT

THE MATTER was referred to the Honorable Edwin G. Torres, United States Magistrate Judge for a Report and Recommendation on Garnishees' Motion for Summary Judgment, Dissolution of Writs, and Attorneys' Fees (**D.E. No. 29**) and Intervenor's Motion for Summary Judgment and to Quash Plaintiff's Writs of Garnishment (**D.E. No. 26**). The Magistrate Judge filed a Report and Recommendation (**D.E. No. 61**) on June 27, 2011. The Court has reviewed the entire file and record. The Court has made a *de novo* review of the issues that the objections to the Magistrate Judge's Report and Recommendation present, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises, it is

ADJUDGED that United States Magistrate Judge Edwin G. Torres's Report and

Recommendation (D.E. No. 61) on June 27, 2011 is AFFIRMED and ADOPTED in part.

Accordingly, it is

ADJUDGED that:

(1) Plaintiff cannot satisfy the default judgment that she obtained against the Government

of Cuba by garnishing payments owed by the listed air charter companies. Since Plaintiff

does not have the required license from the United States Department of Treasury's Office

of Foreign Asset Control, the writs of garnishment are null and void. Furthermore, in this

case, neither the Foreign Sovereign Immunities Act nor the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act

authorizes garnishment.

(2) Therefore, the Garnishees' Motion for Summary Judgment, Dissolution of Writs, and

Attorneys' Fees (D.E. No. 29) is GRANTED in part as to the writs of garnishment which

should be dissolved and DENIED as to the remainder of the motion.

(3) For the foregoing reasons, the Government's Motion for Summary Judgment and to

Quash Plaintiff's Writs of Garnishment (**D.E. No. 26**) is GRANTED.

(4) This case is CLOSED and all pending motions are DENIED as moot.
